# THE STEVE LANGLEY CUP

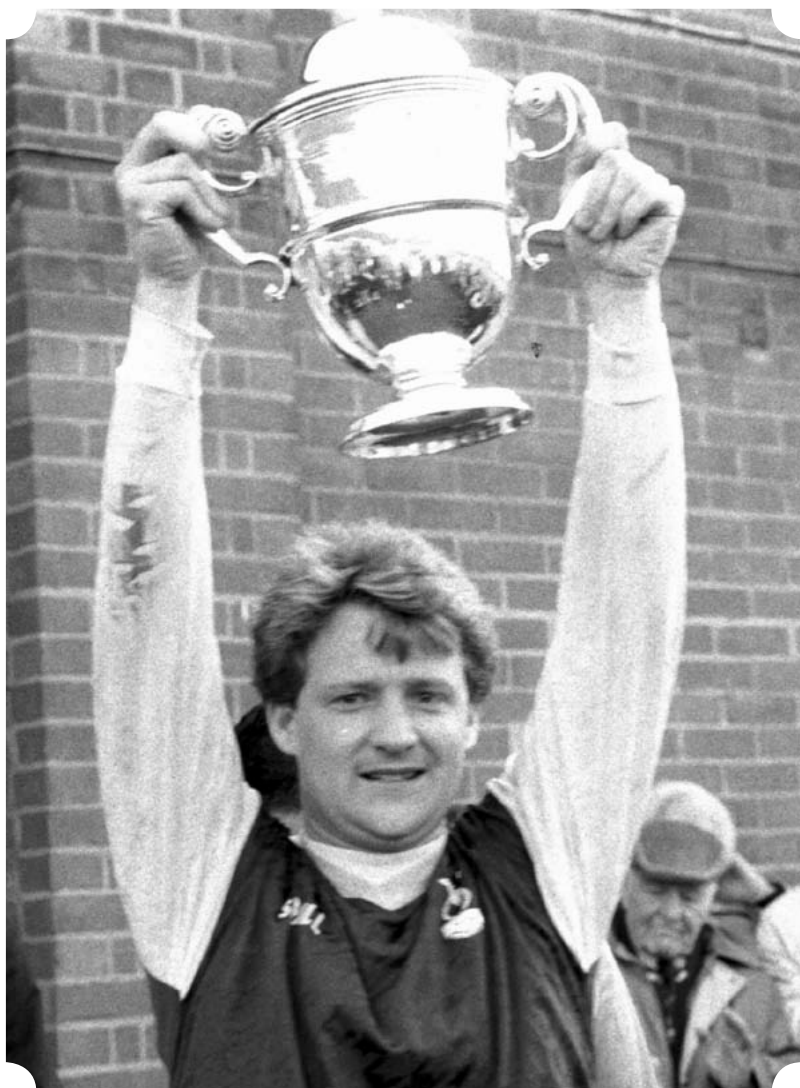
The Steve Langley Cup is contested annually in memory of the former SAL and Crouch End Vampires captain who died, aged 42, from lung cancer. Steve was a strong centre-back who led the Vampires during the 1990s as they became one of the best teams in AFA football. Steve appeared in two AFA Senior Cup finals, winning the Cup in 1994 as well as the AFA Middlesex Cup in 1996 and regularly challenging in the SAL First Division.
